

Manuscript Preparation Guideline

Intellectus is the Journal of Philosophy in Africa that focuses on understanding philosophy with the perspective of its practical applications to issues in Africa. Manuscripts for *Intellectus* should be between **7000-8000 words** in length and be prepared according to the following style:

Abstract and Keywords

The manuscript should have **an abstract of 150-200 words** and a list of **5-6 keywords**, which should all be in both English and French.

Text Layout

Submissions to *Intellectus* should be between 7000-8000 words in length and be prepared according to the following style:

The layout should be simple, and of consistent style in terms of font, headings, paragraphs and spacing. Articles should be typewritten using Times New Roman 12pt and should be justified. All headings should be formatted as bold, left indented with double spacing above and a single space below.

The headings should have a continuous numbering starting with '0' for the

'Introduction' (i.e., 0. Introduction, 1. Heading A, 2. Heading B etc.), the sub-headings and sub-sub-headings should be numbered accordingly (e.g., as 1.1, or 2.1.1 etc.).

The first line of every paragraph should be indented. There must be a minimal use of underlining, italics, upper and lowercase letters. Non-English terms, emphasis, and title of any material should be set in italics rather than underlined. *Intellectus* follows the British style of quotation, which means single quotation marks are for dialogue and quoted materials in the text, while double quotation marks are for quotes inside quotes. In addition, all quoted texts that are longer than three lines (about fifty words) should be consistently indented, with a single space between the previous texts and between the consequent texts.

Any image contained in the manuscript should be forwarded separately, along with the submission, in **jpg** format and not more than 70 KB in size.

Referencing

Authors should use the Chicago Manual of Style Author-Date system for the reference list

entry. There should be no footnotes; all bibliographic entries should appear as Endnotes without numbering. Authors should use in text citation rather than numbering. Authors are encouraged to kindly visit: http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html and click on the Author-Date tab for more details.

Language Version

Authors are to use either the UK or US version of English language, but they are encouraged to maintain a strict consistence to one of the two version used in their manuscripts.

Additional Information in the Article

The Author is free to notify the Editor of any important information, especially acknowledgements, that should be included in the accepted article.
